Tension and sadness are the hindrance of fluency. Common people cannot overcome these issues and cannot be fluent. But an expert seldom cares for these factors. He is fluent always irrespective of his state of mind. Similarly, mundane affairs cannot touch a pious soul. Such a sacred soul is always happy by the influence of divine grace.

A book becomes best seller when it is fluent and lucid. Lucidity is the synonym of fluency. Such a book conquers the head and heart of lay readers. Also the scholars enjoy such an easy going book.
